Myra Wrubel (9 Deerhill Road) asked about the pond and stated that when it was dredged the water would go into the creek.

68 Mountainview related that the storm drains are going into the outside drainage pit and that they had to evacuate. The water is coming from Cresskill.

The Borough Attorney will send a letter to Cresskill to try and solve this situation.

53 County Road—erosion is close to the foundation. The Mayor spoke to the County Executive and the County Roads people. She is working on this.

Charlie Wrubel (9 Deerhill Road) questioned the bonding process to make repairs.

Mr. Miller (18 Old Stable Road) stated that the brook has not been dredged in 30 years.

Mr. Carroll moved to close to the public, second Mr. Connelly. All in favor. Carried.

Mr. Carroll moved for Adjournment, second Mrs. La Pira. All in favor. Meeting adjourned at 8:20 pm.
